Himalayan University Consortium Steering Committee meeting

18-19 April 2024 | ICIMOD, Kathmandu

Background

The Steering Committee is the Himalayan University Consortium's (<u>HUC</u>) highest governing body. The committee's meetings set the course of action for the consortium for the calendar year and track the progress of the implementation of HUC Strategy 2018–2025.

The 2024 meeting is critical for the committee to discuss the Evaluation Report of the HUC by an independent reviewing team, commissioned by ICIMOD and the draft of the Position Paper on the HUC Governance prepared by the HUC Task Force on Sustainability and Resource Mobilization. Apart from members' business agenda items and welcoming a new Member representing China, the Committee will discuss HUC-specific queries raised by the ICIMOD Programme Advisory Committee at the network-focused session during its meeting in Kathmandu on 19 January 2024.

Objectives

- HUC Steering Committee members will provide updates on the state of higher education for sustainability and the HUC Country Chapter formation process in their home country.
- The HUC Secretariat will provide updates on the consortium's collaborative capacity building, research, and publication, as well as the budget and staffing of the Secretariat and member-led resource mobilization in 2023.
- The SC will discuss the independent Evaluation Report of the HUC commissioned by ICIMOD.
- The SC will discuss the draft of the Position Paper on HUC Governance prepared by the HUC Task Force on Sustainability and Resource Mobilization.
